Lacrosse Defenseman Earns Top Writing Award for Essay

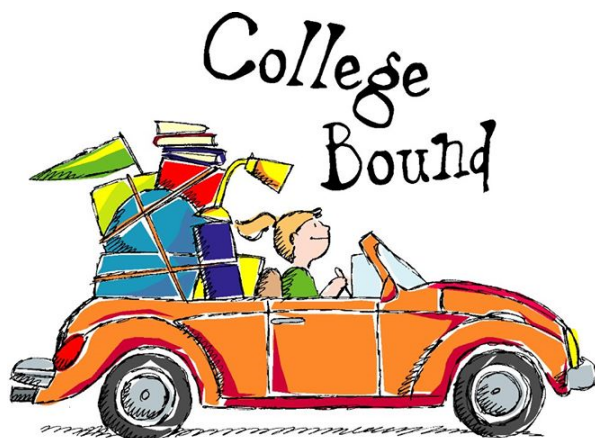


Marshall defends the goal during a recent match. He plans to play lacrosse in college next year at a Division II school.

Fall: The Perfect Time to Visit College Campuses

If the roar of the crowd at the football game doesn't appeal, perhaps the taste of crisp homemade apple crisp or a trek through the quad at noon will entice you. Autumn is the time when college campuses invite prospective students and parents to come and discover. Here are tips to make the most of your visit:



1. **Reserve your spot.** Call the college and request a specific time for a visit. Game tickets, information sessions and meals are often included in scheduled visits. Check the college website for dates.
2. **Take notes and pictures.** Once you have returned home, it's difficult to compare/contrast colleges without documentation. Write and snap away.
3. **Allot enough time.** Don't try to crowd three visits in a day. Allow at least a half day per school to get a true feel not only for the campus but its surrounding area.
4. **Go beyond the tour.** Wander around the dining hall, check out the library, visit a classroom.
5. **Ask questions.** Ask the guide about topics that matter to **you**, such as food, fun, traditions, etc.
