



## Engineers Take First Steps

Sarasota needs engineers. The Innovation Station, a part of the new Gator Engineering program between SCF and UF, has found a way to keep engineering students in the area instead of losing them to bigger cities.

The Gulf Coast Community Foundation funded the program to provide local students a pathway to an engineering degree with local support from leading businesses. Patty Harris, program coordinator, says the program's main goal is to give each student special attention, mentoring and guidance to thrive during and after college. Students will study for the first two years at SCF and transfer to UF during their junior year.

### **Dual Enrollment Options Open**

Rising sophomores and juniors can sign up for dual enrollment at STC, SCF, or USF through April. Students need to have good attendance and meet the minimum GPA for admission. For SCF and USF, a PERT test may be required. Come to the Career Center or visit Guidance for information.
