Per Dr. Jim Minor:

- For Graduation kids get 8 tickets for Sat night. If it rains, graduation will be Sunday morning.
- **Per Mary** – we asked for an IB representative to be on the committee.
- There was a successful pullout with seniors and they had their final college update which shows where the seniors have been accepted, a total of 119 schools.
- There was a college counseling mini workshop on college essays.
- There was a sophomore pullout, 6 alumni returned, 2 from 2004, 1 from 2006, 2 from 2010 and 1 from 2014. It was very successful, they all talked about the value of the IB program, including the value of failure. The program lasted 2 periods and was very well received.
- IB exams start on 4/26/18. We need help proctoring the exams. We have to ship them out with 24 hours of completion. The exams go all over the place, and the scores come back on July 6th. IB doesn't do make up exams. The make up exams are not until Nov 6th.
