Principal Update

IB Coordinator Update

- CAS celebration was 4/10, underclassmen got to view posters. Thank you to Tommy, Amy, Linda for getting all CAS poster set up.
- IB application for 2019-2020 school year are over 400.
- E2 initiative funding at over \$64,000. 27 seniors in DP on free or reduced lunch stats are 75% 1st generation college, 60% minority, in scholarships accepted over 3.4 million averaging out to \$128,000 per student, up from last year at 50,000. Showing the positive impact of the case managers that assist these students. School board would like to do publicity on this.
- Last Mile Fund has been established to assist the students in E2 initiative in taking away any final barriers to college. Example Dr. Minor gave was a student whose family did not have housing deposit, with this fund Dr. Minor paid the deposit using foundation credit card.
- IB Theater Awards on 4/10, a classy event. Thank you for on going IBPO financial support.
