Summer Assignment 2023 IB Spanish 4 (Juniors) Due Date: Thursday, August 17

To prepare you for part 1 of the internal assessment that you will do your senior year, you will be practicing your writing and speaking skills. Follow all the instructions below and look at the rubric to make sure that you have met all the requirements. When you are added to the Teams for our class you will attach this document to the assignment, so make sure you save it in your OneDrive where you will know where to access it later.

1. Pick **1** of the photos below. Each of the photos is tied to one of the themes that we will study in this class.





2. Describe the picture in **complete sentences** in **Spanish**.

There is a sheet called "Useful Phrases for the IA" attached to this assignment. Use this to include all the necessary details in your written description. Answer the following questions in your description. Highlight the questions as you use them so you can keep track.

- a. ¿Qué colores se utilizan en la imagen? (What colors are used in the image?)
- b. ¿Qué efecto o simbolismo tienen los colores utilizados? (What effect or symbolism do the colors used have?)
- c. ¿Cómo se utiliza la luz? (How is the light used?)
- d. ¿Se divide la imagen o está todo en un plano? (Is the image divided or is everything on one plane?)
- e. ¿Quién o qué aparece en la imagen? (Who and what appears in the image?)
- f. ¿Qué postura tiene(n)? (What posture do they have?)
- g. ¿Qué expresión tiene(n) en la cara? (What expresión do they have on their face?)
- h. ¿Aparecen las personas solas o en grupos? (Are the people alone or in groups?)
- i. ¿Dónde se encuentran? (Where are they?)
- j. ¿Qué otras cosas/objetos/etc. aparecen en la imagen? (What other things/objects/etc. appear in the image?)

k. ¿Qué están haciendo? (What are they doing?) <u>Vocabulary:</u> You must use at least **10** words/phrases from the "Useful Phrases for the IA" handout.

<u>Grammar</u>: Present tense only. Here we can use the verb *ser* when describing the image. Es or son is the appropriate use in this content. Remember that the verb *estar* is used for temporary condition and the condition of the picture does not change. However, *estar* is used to describe emotions. Therefore, if you describe the emotion of a subject by their facial expression, then you may use está or parece estar.

- 5. Create a Flipgrid video reading your written description. This will be posted as a separate assignment, as there will be a different rubric associated with it. Remember that it is not about having perfect pronunciation but speaking with confidence. If you make a mistake, try to correct yourself once and then keep going.

**You will be graded using rubrics that come from IB, so make sure you take a look at both the writing and speaking rubrics attached to the assignment.
