To help you practice for part 1 of the internal assessment that you will take this year, you will be practicing your writing and speaking skills. Follow all of the instructions below and look at the rubrics attached to the assignment in Teams to make sure that you have met all of the requirements.

1. Pick **1** of the photos below. Each of the photos is tied to one of the themes that we will study in this class.

2. Look up **10 vocabulary terms** that you would need to describe the picture. Write the words in Spanish and English in the table below. Complete this by **Wednesday, June 21st**.

3. Now that you have your 10 vocabulary terms, write **10 complete sentences** in **Spanish** describing the picture using the terms that you have just learned. Remember that in order to be a complete sentence, you need a **conjugated verb**. Keep the following questions in mind as you write your written description.
- ¿Qué colores se ve en la foto? (What colors are seen in the photo?)
 - ¿Qué ves en la foto? - personas, objetos, etc. (What do you see in the photo? – people, objects, etc.)
 - ¿Dónde están las personas en la foto? (Where are the people in the photo?)
Remember that we use *estar* to describe the location of people and things.
 - ¿Qué están haciendo las personas en la foto? (What are the people doing in the photo?)

Vocabulary: You must use all **10** of the vocabulary terms that you looked up in part 2.

Grammar: Present tense only. Here we can use the verb *ser* when describing the image. *Es* or *son* is the appropriate use in this content. Remember that the verb *estar* is used for temporary condition and the condition of the picture does not change. However, *estar* is used to describe emotions. Therefore, if you describe the emotion of a subject by their facial expression, then you may use *está* or *parece estar*.

- Picture: Copy and paste the picture that you have chosen below.

- Theme: **Choose an item.**

- Written Description: **15 complete sentences in Spanish.** Complete this by **Thursday, August 10.**

4. Identify the following items in your written description:
 - a. Underline the **subject** in each sentence. (la mujer, el hombre, él, ella, etc.)
 - b. **Highlight** all of the **verbs** in each sentence in **green**. (If you are color-blind, you may put your verbs in **bold** (CTRL + B).
5. Read through your written description and do a spelling and grammar check. Remember that the correct use of accent marks is also included in spelling and grammar. If you do not know already know how to type accent marks, look at the instructions attached to this assignment. Double-check to make sure that all of your verbs (in green) are conjugated correctly for the subject that you underlined.
6. Create a Flipgrid video reading through your written description. This will be posted as a separate assignment, as there will be a different rubric associated with it. Remember that it is not about having perfect pronunciation, but try to speak confidently. If you make a mistake, try to correct yourself once and then keep going. This is due by **Friday, August 18**.
