Tarea de verano 2024-2025 BI Español 6 (NS)

The summer assignment is divided up into **3** parts, with one being due in June, one in July, and one in August. Please make sure that you do not procrastinate so you turn in good quality work.

Parte 1: Lista de vocabulario (**Due Friday**, **June 19, 2024**)

- 1. Fill out the vocabulary chart with **50** vocabulary words from your assigned short story, their English translation, and their synonym. You will use this to write your summary. Completa el organizador "Vocabulario nuevo del cuento" con palabras, expresiones, y términos nuevos del cuento con su significado en inglés.
- 2. Create a Quizlet with the title of your story and the selected terms of your choice. Attach the link to the Quizlet to the assignment on Teams. Crea un Quizlet con el titulo del cuento con los términos escogidos. Adjunta el enlace del Quizlet en la tarea en Teams.
- 50 points for the vocabulary list with translations and synonyms.
- 50 points for the link to the Quizlet created. You must have a Quizlet account to do this.

Parte 2: Resumen del cuento corto (**Due Friday**, **July 19, 2024**)

- 1. Read the assigned short story according to your last name. Lee el cuento corto que corresponde a tu apellido.
- 2. Create PowerPoint summarizing 8 events from the story in Spanish. You must write 3 complete sentences in Spanish as well as draw or insert a picture to describe each scene. In total your presentation will have 24 complete sentences in Spanish and 8 images or pictures. Use your own words and do not repeat the words from the story. Crea un PowerPoint que resuma 8 eventos de la historia en español. Debes escribir 3 oraciones completas en español y dibujar o insertar una imagen para describir cada escena. En total, tu presentación tendrá 24 oraciones completas en español y 8 imágenes. Usa tus propias palabras y no repitas las palabras de la historia.

You will have a title page, and 8 slides with 2-3 complete sentences describing what happened in the story using simple terms (without using the same words from the literature). NO ENGLISH WORDS AT ALL. You must have a visual that represents your description of the event in that scene.

You must use the template already attached to the assignment in Teams. The attached document is already your own copy. **Do not attach your own document.**

<u>Parte 3:</u> Descripción de la idea principal y el tema del cuento corto (**Due Friday, August 16, 2024**)

Write **written description**, not a summary, of what happened in the story in **300-350** words as follows:

- 1. **Description**: (**100-125 words**) Write a summary of the theme of the extract, the main idea, or the message (you must paraphrase the story in your own words)
- 2. **Connection to the rest of the story & culture**: (**150-175 words**) Here you must explain what happened **before** and **after** the extract (provide context) and make the connection with the whole story to prove that you have read the entire story and not just the extract. Include a **cultural** connection. Where could this story take place based on the setting of the story? This must be a **Spanish-speaking** country. Make a strong connection by giving me examples of what this is like that country.
- 3. **Opinion**: **(100-225 words)** Lastly, write your opinions and personal contributions on the characters, events, themes, moral of the story, and ideas. For example? If I were the character, I would do this. For this, use the **conditional** by adding the -ía ending to the infinitive, but look out for a few irregular verbs. Make sure to include at least **2 subjunctive sentences** and at least **10 words** or **phrases** from the handout titled "Presentación de un fragmento literario".

You must use the template already attached to the assignment in Teams. The attached document is already your own copy. **Do not attach your own document.**
