IB COORDINATOR'S UPDATE/PLANS – Dr. Jim Minor

- Thursday, 9/12, Dr. Minor will represent FLIBS at a meeting with college admissions heads from Florida state colleges & universities
- The IB organization has followed 4 case studies of exemplary IB programming/schools and RHS has been selected for the next feature. RHS was selected from the global pool of IB schools, over 5000 schools.
- RHS IB students volunteered their time to support SSIS, a charter school that is an IB candidate school. The school is roughly 90% minority students & RHS IB has adopted the school for beautification and grounds improvement projects
 - Lowe's and Troy's Tropics, together donated several thousands of dollars in in-kind materials so IB student volunteers could paint, pressure wash, and garden to beautify and improve campus grounds & classrooms. Mr. Chad Smith spearheaded the effort with approximately 30 IB student volunteers.

IB COORDINATOR'S UPDATE/PLAN - Dr. Jim Minor

- 30 students worked at local charter school, SCIS, to beautify and improve classrooms and school grounds, as part of their CAS requirement. Mr. Chad Smith coordinated and oversaw the event
- The IB Organization publishes case studies of exemplary IB schools and RHS was selected to be featured as the next study. This is out of approximately 5000 IB schools globally. With 740 IB students sitting for IB exams last year, the IB organization is very excited to spotlight RHS and its successes
- 9/12: Dr. Minor will be representing FLIBS (Association of Florida IB Schools) at a meeting of Florida state college and university heads of admissions
- At the 9/11 mandatory senior parent meeting at 7 PM, parents of seniors will be given the same information their child received on the 9/4 IB Community day
