PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE – Mrs. Erin Haughey

- Parent Survey open now and feedback is appreciated. It is looked at closely for changes to next school year.
- IB Budget is intact and want to reassure families and students. Due to district budget cuts as a result of decreased enrollment, thus less students per capita, funding has decreased. Since Riverview has maintained acceleration monies, Riverview IB is not affected, and staffing will remain as is.
- Plan to align acceptance timelines for AICE, Booker VPA HS, and IB programs. Will provide early acceptance for Sarasota County students
- Creating an AD campaign to promote Riverview and IB program. Misnomers are being spread. Action for district to release 1-page summaries and explain each program at their respective high school.
- School choice is open and there are 40 spots at Riverview that are non IB in addition to the IB seats. Goal is 2650 student body total.
- Juniors will all take the school-based ACT on 2/24 during first thru 3rd period online at school.
- Juniors can begin to sign up for their upcoming senior photos.
- Seniors – the RHS foundation scholarships are open and deadline is April 1.
- Senior Attendance Challenge in place. Can win prizes such as grad bash, prom cap and gown. Need 97 and 93 percent attendance to achieve prizes.
- All Rising seniors have picked classes and have begun working on rising Juniors.
- Career fair will be March 12 and looking for volunteers from 7:45 – 2 pm in the gym. Can add your business if interested. Openings for summer jobs will also be available.
- R Store - Needing throw blankets, easy cook meals, interview clothing, ties.
- Grad Bash 2026 – tickets are limited and on sale now. Event is on April 17.



IB COORDINATOR'S UPDATE/PLAN – Dr. Jim Minor

- 414 IB applications, mainly freshmen class have been submitted
- No major legislation presented for this year that will impact IB or its funding
- March Community Day: 9th grade will discuss what is an IB education and the mission statement. 10th grade will meet IB alumni in law and medical fields. 11th grade will have a college essay workshop utilizing common App prompts. 12th grade will work on marketing IB with Dr. Minor.

- Mrs. Ellis, Administrative assistant has been promoted and will be leaving. Mark Kidd who has been with Riverview for past 10 years will be replacing.
