STRONG GPA FOR THE **CURRENT YEAR**

GPA in five CORE credits

MS credits do not count toward HS GPA for PIB

- NO D's or F's
- **ATTENDANCE**
- **BE IN GOOD STANDING in IB**

Students **NOT** meeting these requirements will be moved out of the Pre-IB program.

Students not districted to RHS will be required to attend their districted school.



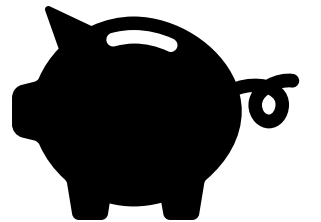
Community Service

RHS Math Placement Test Registration 26-27

Who needs to take the placement Test?

- All Middle School Students in Algebra 1 Honors, Geometry, or Geometry Honors.
- All Middle School Students wanting to take any Honors Math class.
- Any Middle school student wishing to double up on math courses.
 - Any Middle school student enrolling in IB

Placement Tests dates are 4/30, 5/19, and 5/20. All tests are given in the Riverview High School cafeteria. Testing starts at 5:30pm and ends at 7:00pm. You must sit for the full 90 minutes. Please show up at least 15 minutes prior to the test start time.
